HISTORY

North Shore CWL Parish Council Bursary

- * this yearly initiative started in 2000 by five North Shore CWL Councils to provide \$1,200 to a selected Catholic student in their parishes as an encouragement for them to enter post-secondary education.
- * attributes and criteria for students applying include not only being a practicing and participating Catholic member in their Parish, but must also be involved in their Community.
- * through committee selection, the bursary is given to a son, daughter, grandson or granddaughter of a CWL member who is in good standing in a Parish CWL Council one year prior to the student's application for the bursary.

MEN'S SHELTER MINISTRY

Our CWL organizes a social service initiative called the **Men's Shelter Ministry** which provides a meal, once a month, to the downtown
Catholic Men's Shelter which is under the care of the Archdiocese of
Vancouver. On a designated Friday, volunteers purchase and prepare 20
individually wrapped sandwiches and baked goods in their own home.

Donations are dropped off in the school parking lot and transported to the Men's Shelter downtown. This outreach helps those suffering from hunger and homelessness.

100 YEARS STRONG

The National Council of the Catholic Women's League of Canada, decided in 2020, that for the 100th year anniversary of the League in Canada, every CWL Parish Council throughout Canada, should plant a tree to commemorate this occasion.

In the summer of 2021, St. Pius X CWL Council planted a dogwood tree on the parish grounds behind the parking lot and opposite the school gym to honor this event and our own Parish Council's 25th Anniversary. A plaque was placed saying, "This Tree Commemorates the Catholic Women's League of Canada 100th Anniversary ... The St. Pius X Parish Council 25th Anniversary, 2020.

DOMESTIC ABUSE SERVICES - "To Live Without Fear"

In 1995, after learning spousal abuse was a significant problem in our society; five women from various walks of life in Vancouver decided to meet every month to discuss this concern. These women became the founding members of 'Our Lady of Good Counsel Society' under the auspices of the Catholic Women's League in Vancouver. Later, the name changed to **Domestic Abuse Services [DAS] - Our Lady of Good Counsel Society** to reflect more clearly its mission.

Since 1999, workshops are given at high schools on identifying and dealing with abusive relationships.

In 2001, DAS was invited by the Archdiocese to address couples taking the Marriage Preparation Course and this has continued over the years.

In May, 2008 DAS was able to purchase a house that is used as a second-stage transition house for victims of domestic violence and their children. This house has four independent units and provides the residents with a safe home environment to heal, to learn, to be independent, and to break the cycle of violence in their lives.
