

Embracing God's Desire and Will

Today's Scripture readings seem really strong and terrifying. They show us a side of God with which we are generally not very comfortable. We prefer to meet a God who is infinitely patient, who pardons us even when we act completely against him. We prefer the God shown to us in the Gospel of John, who assures us: "I have not come to condemn but to save."

We must read these readings carefully. Sometimes we get caught up only in the awful fear that God will condemn us. The readings from the Prophet Isaiah and the Gospel of Matthew are much more nuanced than that.

On the one hand, these readings refer to people who simply will not budge at all from their rejection of God and of his Christ. On the other hand, can't we feel a blast of the Lord's frustration with those who will not accept his invitation, those who will not even listen to his word at all? Too often the mercy and compassion of God become our justifications for not doing very much. We dilly and dally with sin and with temptations, wanting to be better but not wanting to take the tough decisions that will actually change our lives. We are truly human in that sense, but we lack the redeemed humanity of our Lord Jesus.

We need to become like the person we see in the reading from the Letter of St. Paul to the Philippians: true, honourable, just, pure, loving, and gracious. Our lives can be so different when we begin to live for the Lord. We can stop living in the dread and fear of having to give up our sinfulness, and instead embrace the strong life of those who still sin but whose hearts have become set on doing the will of the Lord.

How do we leave behind this fear of giving up our sinfulness and reach that place where our hearts are set on doing the will of the Lord? The only way is to keep asking God to change us and transform us. We cannot make this change by our own willpower. It is a change that is given to us and effected in us as a free and loving gift from the Lord our God – if we keep asking him for it. It is important that we ask with sincerity and truth, even acknowledging that we want to but perhaps don't really want to give up all of our sinfulness. But we can surely bring ourselves in sincerity and truth to ask the Lord to remove all from within us that is contrary to his desire and will.

In this Thanksgiving season, may the Lord give us strength and courage today as we celebrate these divine mysteries once again. May we be willing to be transformed by his love for us.

Empowering Our Parish Vision


Each year, Project Advance inspires us to come together as a community of faith in Jesus Christ to support various ministries and programs of the Archdiocese and in our parishes.

All funds raised that are in excess of the parish goal set by the Archdiocese (\$29,400, plus the cost of materials needed for the appeal) will be dedicated this year to the commission of an Ambo to complete our sanctuary. The marble ambo will complement our marble altar in design, detail, and proportion. The total estimate for all components of this project – materials, construction, installation, and labour – is \$27,000.
