



Faith and Commitment

Job asks us today, "Is not man's life on earth a drudgery?" Well, yes, but we know that eventually Job receives many gifts from God because his faith does not fail. We may contrast the feelings of Job in today's first reading with those of Jesus in the Gospel: "Let us go on to the nearby villages so that I may preach there also. For this purpose have I come." In his First Letter to the Corinthians, St. Paul shares with us his challenges, "All this I do for the sake of the Gospel, so that I too may have a share in it."

In these three readings today we are given a glimpse into the inner sensibilities of three different people, into their relationships with what the Father is asking of them. We may consider them in this order: Job speaks before knowing of the salvation given to us in Christ Jesus. Jesus speaks to us of his inner calling to proclaim the Good News. St. Paul then encourages us how to proclaim that Good News so that all may come to know Jesus.

Most of us probably already know the story of Job. He is a man who believes completely in the Lord and receives enormous blessings in his life. The devil tries to undo Job's firm faith. Eventually all his blessings are removed and sufferings are then heaped on Job. But while Job questions what is happening, he never doubts nor loses faith in God.

Are we that strong in our faith? Can we trust God even when we have plenty to question? Do we accept both blessings and sufferings from our Lord?

The second reading from the First Letter to the Corinthians is St. Paul's account of how he tries to live the Good News. St. Paul is clear: He must preach the Good News! Here we witness St. Paul not just enduring all of his trials and tribulations, but also recognizing that preaching the Good News is required of him because he believes in Jesus.

Does our faith compel us to share it with others? Are we able to tell others about our faith in Jesus? Are we willing to suffer because we believe that Jesus is the Lord?

We read from St. Mark's Gospel today. We are still at the beginning of this Gospel. Jesus is just beginning his public ministry. What emerges strongly in this Gospel is that everyone is looking for Jesus, and that there is no place to be found for him to be away in solitude from the people. Jesus responds to this situation by saying, "Let us go on to the nearby villages so that I may preach there also. For this purpose have I come."

The whole purpose of the life and ministry of Jesus is to preach the Kingdom, to proclaim the Good News: God loves us and invites us to share his life.

Can we believe it? Do we want to live this belief? Are we willing to share this belief?
