

The Abiding Presence of Jesus

Today's Solemnity celebrates the Ascension of Jesus into heaven. He is no longer with us in the ways that he was during his earthly lifetime and immediately after his Resurrection. It is not easy for us to understand completely all that happened in those days after the Resurrection. We must trust in the Scriptures that have been handed down to us. There was clearly an experience of Jesus truly risen from the dead and living in a completely different way from before his death. Then there was an experience of his absence before these early disciples received the Holy Spirit.

The first reading today from the Acts of the Apostles speaks directly of the experience of these early followers of Jesus. They saw him go up to heaven and disappear from their sight, but there is a promise in this reading that Jesus will return in the same way.

The second reading today from St. Paul's Letter to the Ephesians speaks in a less concrete manner, telling us that God raised Jesus from the dead and seated him at his right hand in the heavens. This is painted as an image or a vision because heaven, even in the Scriptures, is not seen as simply another part of our concrete world, but as a reality of a completely different type than we experience here. On the other hand, we always use earthly images to describe heaven because they are the images that we know and understand.

St. Mark's Gospel today gives us some of the last words of Jesus to his followers. The important words to hear and remember here are that he will be with us to the end of time.

At the heart of this mystery of the Ascension is the reality that Jesus is no longer with his followers – with us – in the same way, but that he is always with us, even to the end of time. We do not always feel his presence. Sometimes we doubt his presence. Nevertheless, he is always true to us and present to us.

Because of this incomplete reality, we continue to ask for the Holy Spirit to be with us in a way that keeps us aware of the presence of Jesus in every aspect of our lives. We need to know and feel the presence of Jesus. We need the assurance that his presence is always with us in and through the Holy Spirit.

Our focus and attention today are moving naturally from the Ascension to Pentecost, to the presence of the Holy Spirit. This is the Spirit of Jesus who will deepen the faith in our hearts if we ask for it. Come, Holy Spirit! Help us to understand and accept these mysteries of our faith. Help us to grow deeper in our faith. Help us to know your presence and your inspiration. Help us to experience and to rejoice in the love of Jesus in our lives. Come, Holy Spirit!
