

ALL SOULS DAY ENVELOPES

The month of November is traditionally the time when Catholics pray for all the deceased and have Masses offered for our loved ones who have left this world. We believe that prayer for the dead assists those who are not yet ready to enter Heaven to pass through their time purification and purgation (Purgatory). Very few of us are completely prepared to enter the presence of God when we leave this life we may still be carrying the temporal weight of our sins (not having made restitution, atonement, etc.) or still have an attachment to unholy ways of thinking and behaving which displease Our Lord. Hence the need for Purgatory, which is one of the most consoling doctrines of our Faith. In short, it tells us that while most of us are not ready to go straight to Heaven, we are also not bad enough (in the eyes of our Merciful God) for Hell.

Purgatory also allows us to exercise our love for the faithful departed and offer them real and practical assistance. Prayer, good works, and almsgiving can all be offered on behalf of individual deceased persons or all the dead. In fact, these souls—whom we call the Holy Souls because they are sure of going to Heaven—cannot help but depend on our prayers offered by the Church here on earth and the merits of the blessed in Heaven, in turn, they pray for us and we are allowed and encouraged to ask them to help us, much as we pray to the saints.

When Mass if offered, the priest renews the Sacrifice of Jesus for the glory of God and the needs of the whole Church and all mankind. He prays for the triumph of the Faith, the salvation of all men and women, the temporal and spiritual good of the living and conversion of sinners; he prays for the dead, that they may find their place in the Kingdom of Heaven. However. In addition to these "universal intentions" Catholics have always dedicated Masses to certain special or particular intentions; we pray for peace in time of war; rain in the time of drought, healing for the sick. These special needs forma particular prayer which the priest offers as part of the intention of the Mass.

All Souls Day envelopes have been placed at the entrance of the Church. Please return your envelopes to the collection basket or directly to Father Patrick.

Also be reminded that each intention listed should be \$10.
